

New Member Orientation

Range Orientation is a mandatory requirement for all new members and former members who have not renewed their membership for 2 years. The Orientation Officer's telephone and email address are on the website.

- 1. Print the application form and read the range and safety rules from the website.**
- 2. Contact the Orientation Officer to set up an appointment.**
- 3. On the day of orientation bring a completed application with a cheque for the correct membership fee plus \$10 for the orientation fee, your PAL and appropriate eye and ear protection. Meet the Orientation Officer at the gate to Heffley Creek Gun Club.**
- 4. Gate unlocking and locking procedure and rules around gate control will be explained. Signing in procedure will be explained especially in regards to bringing guest(s). Range closures because of special events and cattle grazing will also be clarified.**
- 5. Range and safety rules will be handed out and discussed on site at the rifle and pistol ranges. Signage for the opening and closing of different ranges will be explained along with safety and cleanup demands. You bring it to the range, you take it home.**
- 6. Members have no access to the shotgun tower, black powder trails and cowboy area without prior approval and certification from an appropriate director. Members need to be actively involved in shotgun, black powder or cowboy to use these venues; however the majority of members use the rifle and pistol ranges only.**
- 7. Club history, range configuration, roles and authority of the club executive and range officers will be discussed.**
- 8. On completion of the orientation, the officer will collect the fee, certify the application form and issue a membership card along with a key to the range.**
