

RANGE RULES

1. All members and guests must sign in at the gate. A guest may be signed in only once to use a firearm. If they wish to shoot at the range again, they must join the club.
2. No glass or like objects will be used as targets. Paper targets will be removed after use. Litter from targets, shotgun hulls etc. will be put in the trashcans.
3. If you remove steel targets, stands or other range equipment from storage, it is your responsibility to ensure that after use it is returned to where you got it from.
4. If you wish to borrow something from another venue you must first call a director of that discipline and get the OK to use it. If during a competition there is a dire need for an item, then borrow it and inform the director afterwards. If a borrowed item is damaged, you will have it repaired or replaced.
5. Absolutely no shooting of plywood backboards with shotguns.
6. Absolutely no hunting or harassing of the animals.
7. Absolutely no explosive/binary targets on this range.
8. Do not shoot the signs.
9. If shotgun tower is in use, the pistol range and cowboy town are closed.

Do not fire on a closed range.

If you wish to use another range than the one that is currently open and that other range is not scheduled to be open that day. Then go to that range. Politely ask whoever is using that range to move to a safe area. When it is safe to do so, open the range you wish to use. Do not fire if your bullet could possibly endanger others.

Special note:

The Rifle range normally takes precedent over the other ranges and will be as #3 above unless a scheduled event is taking place on the range. Always check the range schedule on the Club website before heading to the range.
