

RANGE RULES

- 1 No glass or like objects will be used as targets. Paper targets will be removed after use. Litter From targets, shotgun hulls etc. will be put in trash cans provided.
- 2 If you remove steel targets, stands or other range equipment from storage it is your responsibility to insure that after use it is returned to storage.
- 3 If you wish to borrow something from another venue you must first call a director of that discipline and get the O.K. to use it. If during a competition there is a dire need for an item, then borrow it and inform a director afterwards. If an item is damaged you will have it repaired or if consumed replaced.
- 4 Do not miss-use or abuse metal targets or stands, targets for 22 caliber use will not standup to large caliber pistol or rifle bullets. Use paper targets on wooden stands for large caliber bullets at the pistol range.

Due to the configuration of the range complex, for safety reasons some ranges must be closed when other ranges are open.

DISTANCE YOU MAY GO AHEAD

| 1 | RIFLE AND PISTOL OPEN - ALL OTHER RANGES CLOSED | Go ahead only 100 meters on rifle and pistol ranges |
| 2 | RIFLE RANGE OPEN - ALL OTHER RANGES CLOSED. | Go ahead 500 meters on rifle range. |
| 3 | PISTOL RANGE OPEN - ALL OTHER RANGES CLOSED | Go ahead 200 meters on pistol range. |
| 4 | SHOTGUN, COWBOY AND BLACK POWDER OPEN | Rifle and pistol ranges closed. |
| 5 | SHOTGUN AND RIFLE OPEN | Pistol, Cowboy and black powder closed. Go ahead only 100 meters on rifle range. |

Do not fire on a closed rang.

If you wish to use another range than the one that is currently open make sure it is safe to do so. Then change the signs and to comply with one of the scenarios above. Do not do anything that could potently endanger others.
